1. When is AI allowed without restrictions

- Acting as a language assistant (e.g., vocabulary expansion, collocations, synonyms, idioms)
- Proofreading and grammar checks
- Formatting documents
- Practicing specific translation tasks

2. When is AI allowed with restrictions

- Brainstorming (AI may inspire ideas, but do not copy topics, angles, or projects verbatim)
- Data interpretation (AI may assist, but your own analysis must remain central)
- Draft feedback (AI suggestions are not always accurate—evaluate critically)
- Checking/asking for legitimate sources
- Designing visuals for presentations

3. When is AI forbidden.

- Translating entire texts
- During formal assessment (e.g., exams, graded assignments)
- Replacing human authorship in drafting or writing

4. When is AI compulsory.

- To develop AI literacy.
